February Market Update:


A Balanced Market for Buyers & Sellers The Greater Victoria real estate market remained steady in February, with 528 properties sold—up 12.3% from last year and 25.1% from January.

Single-family home sales increased 4.5%, while condo sales surged 26.3%. The benchmark price for a single-family home rose 3.7% to \$1,309,500, while condo prices held steady at \$551,900.

Inventory grew to 2,630 active listings, a 9.8% increase from January. With stable prices, rising inventory, and favorable interest rates, spring is shaping up to be a great time to buy or sell. Need guidance? We're here to help!




Community Spotlight: Six Mile




